ANIMAL CONTROL

Animal Control Director Bob Marshall shared his October 2013 report with the Committee.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Health Department Administrator Tippey advised the Committee they had new floor tiles installed to replace worn carpeting.

Next week she and her assistant will be in Memphis for trainings.

Their counselors for the ACA are doing the best they can with the imperfect website. They have five certified counselors and two more pending. They have done some special events to provide information to the community.

The MOU went through Property Committee with amendments. It will go before the Board on 11/20/13.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Director Neavear reported on the IDPH Well Code which was finalized on 10-27-13. The codes will now coincide. On 12-11-13 there will be a septic contractor training sponsored by Environmental Health.

The Snow and Ice Conference was held on 11/07/13. The target audience was private contractors. Neavear reported it was packed and the conference was a success.

Next week will be Active Shooter training at ICC. It will be a table top exercise.

Neavear reported that Mel Pleines will be stepping down from the Mackinaw Valley Water Authority. It was discussed that his name may be presented for recognition from Public Health in April.

Tippey reported that Bill Ebert has stepped down from the Board of Health.

SOLID WASTE

Supervisor Goetze stated that EPA denied panel glass for an alternative cover.

Harris reported on the Pekin Landfill Sub Committee. The next meeting will include IEPA and Patrick Engineering. He stated Patrick Engineering will have a cost estimate and specifications for the Committee to determine the best path to take for cover.

Neavear reported she also had another call for donated soil. Harris stated they will have a bid package ready for the January meeting.
